What They Do

Custom applicators are responsible for the operation of spray equipment and the effective application of pesticides or fertilizer. They mix, load and apply pesticides and fertilizers to fields at approved applicable rates. In addition to the direct application, they are also often working directly with the farmer to discuss the soil composition, growing plans, and desired outcomes with farmers to make the best decisions about applications to be conducted.

- Operate and maintain all equipment and vehicles
- Mix, load and apply pesticides and fertilizers
- Apply pesticides and fertilizers at applicable rates to the appropriate fields
- Handle and deliver bulk and packaged chemicals
- Perform daily vehicle inspections
- Clean and maintain equipment
- Maintain application/spray records
- Manage customer service relations
- Work with farmers to plan the most efficient and effective program to obtain desired outcomes
- Organize and coordinate application timeline with customers
- Knowledgeable of seed, chemicals, and fertilizers to make informed decisions
- Recertify spraying technicians license and safety training every two years

Education/Training

Certification as a commercial applicator is needed. An associate's degree is not required but would enhance the opportunity to obtain the job.
