What They Do

Food Packagers, pack or package by hand a wide variety of products and materials, including things like meat, fish, vegetables, fruit, pre-cooked meats and drinks.

Job Duties

- Examine and inspect containers, materials, or products to ensure that product quality and packing specifications are met
- Measure, weigh, and count products and materials
- Record product, packaging, and order information on specified forms and records
- Seal containers or materials, using glues, fasteners, nails, and hand tools
- Assemble, line, and pad cartons, crates, and containers using hand tools
- Move materials, equipment, or supplies
- Load materials into equipment for processing
- Mark materials or objects for identification
